Dear Year 12 Parent/Carer

As we commence the holidays at the close of what have been truly unprecedented Spring and Summer Terms for Portadown College, I write to acknowledge my heartfelt gratitude to you, our young people and staff for the positivity and goodwill demonstrated throughout these challenging months. In particular, I wish to place on record my pride in our young people who have exemplified resilience, dedication and industry since the onset of school closure.

At this time, I write to advise you in respect of arrangements for the issue of GCSE results and the anticipated school re-start in August 2020.

Thursday 20 August (GCSE Results Day)

In light of ongoing uncertainty regarding public health, a system of staggered student arrival will operate in the College on Thursday 20 August 2020 to facilitate the collection of GCSE results. Please refer to the table below for information on timings and entrances to the College on that morning categorised into student surname groupings:

In order to safeguard students and staff on Thursday 20 August 2020, I would request that you encourage your son/daughter to adhere to the social distancing and Public Health Agency guidance in place at that time. Please be advised that a one-way system will be in place for collection of results and movement through the College. Students are requested to follow the signage in College accordingly.

In the envelope containing his/her statement of results issued on Thursday 20 August, your son/daughter will also find enclosed information on:

- (i) the steps required for **AS subject choices** to be made by **12 noon on Thursday 20 August 2020**;
- (ii) the steps students not returning to College should follow;
- (iii) access to advice from Heads of Department and the CEIAG Department (Careers Education, Information, Advice and Guidance) on that day.

College Re-Start

In accordance with Department of Education Guidance, it is anticipated that the College will commence a phased re-opening to **Year 12 and Year 14** from **Monday 24 August 2020**.

It is currently planned that all year groups will return to College from **Tuesday 1 September 2020** under a blended learning model which will involve particular year groups and students attending school on selected days.

Given evolving circumstances, I trust you will appreciate that these plans may be subject to change over the forthcoming weeks. Further details will be issued in due course in accordance with the most up-to-date guidance from the Department of Education and Public Health Agency at that time.

Year 13 Induction

A Year 13 Induction session in College is planned for **Friday 28 August 2020**. Your son/daughter will be scheduled to attend either Session 1 **or** Session 2 (please see below), further details of which will be communicated to your son/daughter via the **Year 13 Google Classroom**.

Session 1: 9:30 – 11:00am

or

Session 2: 11:30am – 1:00pm

Accessing Online Information

I am aware that some students may be encountering difficulties accessing information via C2k.

If users need to reset their password from outside school, and they know their previous password, this can be done via the following link: <https://services.c2kni.net/ums/>

Users will be asked to provide their account information and security verification as below:

The new password will have a lifecycle of 120 days.

If a student's password expires and they do not remember their password during the summer holidays, a parent or carer can email resetmypassword@c2kni.org.uk and provide the following information:

- student first name and surname;
- student date of birth;
- student username;
- name of school;
- school address.

When EA staff make contact, the parent/carers will be asked to provide some other details to verify the student's identity. The member of C2k staff will check the details provided against the records held in the school and once verified, will reset the student's password.

Additional Queries

Naturally, you and your son/daughter will no doubt have various questions in relation to the re-start. I trust you will appreciate that given the fluidity of the situation at present, further information will be shared with you in August regarding transport, canteen arrangements and health and safety measures in place here in the College for the commencement of the new term.

As regards school uniform, I wish to advise that the Department of Education has indicated that schools are not a high risk environment and while all children and young people should be encouraged to wear clean uniform each day, this is not essential. In circumstances where you encounter difficulties sourcing uniform items to your son/daughter's requirements, please contact the College Office.
